KUMA's Location

Korea University of Media Arts is located in Sejong Metropolitan Autonomous City. It takes an hour and half for driving from Seoul, the capital city of Korea. Sejong city is a new

administrative capital in administration, education, culture, and welfare.

KUMA was established in 1993, since then, it has continued to invest in specialized departments in order to strengthen their competitiveness. Eventually, it was designated as 'Specialized College of Korea' by the Ministry of Education in 2014.
